## Nomination

International students must be nominated by their home institution during the term of the agreement. Required information: full name, email, course, period of exchange and academic transcript. Nominations should be sent by email to: cooperation@ucb.br

After analysis by the respective course coordinator and approval of the nomination, the Internationalization Coordination will send an email to international students about the next steps.

# Deadline for nomination

May 1st (for exchanges starting in August)

December 1st (for exchanges starting in February)

## Requirements

- Be selected and nominated by the home institution.
- Have the nomination approved by the course coordinator and the Internationalization sector.

It is important to keep in mind that all classes are taught in **Portuguese**.



International students **must** have a VITEM IV visa <u>(student visa)</u>. For information on the required documents, visit the website of the Brazilian Embassy in your country.

Health insurance is mandatory to enroll at UCB.

## Grading system

The grading system at UCB ranges from 0 to 10. To pass a subject, the student must achieve at least a grade of 7.0 and have a minimum attendance of 75%.

### Academic Calendar

1st semester: February - June 2nd semester: August – December

## Monthly Fees and Rates

Students from partner universities can undertake exchange programs for up to one semester without paying monthly fees or taxes.

#### Arrival

We recommend that students plan their arrival in Brasília at least 1 week before the start of the academic semester, according to the academic calendar.

## Cost of living

It is recommended to set aside around R\$1,200 per month plus accommodation.

#### Accommodation

UCB does not have student housing or accommodation. However, we can suggest some accommodation options near the university. The choice of accommodation, as well as its costs, are the sole responsibility of the student and must be paid directly to the service provider. The approximate cost of accommodation per month can be between R\$1,600 and R\$2,400 (based on values from 05/2025 for accommodation in neighborhoods close to UCB).



# Transport

To get to UCB, students can get off at the Taguatinga Sul subway station, which is a 20-minute walk from the university; or get off at the bus stop located in front of the institution's main entrance.
